Kirtipur Municipality, Office of the Municipal Executive invites electronic bids from Nepalese eligible bidders for the construction of **the Bhajangal Chok to Garudsthan Road Improvement (KRM – 30/2077/078)** under National Competitive Bidding procedures. The estimated amount for the works is Rs. 24,38,573.50 (**inclusive VAT**).
2. Eligible Bidders may obtain further information and inspect the Bidding Documents at the PPMO website www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp.
3. Bidder must submit their bid electronically. For e-bid the bidder can download the bidding documents from PPMO's Web Site www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp. Bidders, submitting their bid electronically, should deposit the cost of bid documents fee of Nrs. 3,000/- of bidding document in the Project's Rajaswa (revenue) account as specified below and the scanned copy (pdf format) of the Bank deposit voucher shall be uploaded by the bidder at the time of electronic submission of the bids.

4. Pre-bid meeting shall not be held.
5. Electronic bids must be submitted through PPMO website www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before 12:00, 14th March, 2021 (1st Chaitra, 2077). Bids received after this deadline will be rejected.
6. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 14:00, on 14th March, 2021 (1st Chaitra, 2077) at the office of the municipal Executive, Kirtipur Municipality. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in .pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of 55,000/- which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
7. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
